We will be celebrating books and reading on World Book Day again this year, including sharing stories across the school and looking at some of our favourite picture books and authors.


In previous years, children and teachers have enjoyed dressing up as a book character. This year, we are going to invite the school community to get in to spirit in one of two ways. You can choose to either:
