Polite Reminder - Reducing the number of adults / overcrowding on site

In line with our Risk Assessment for opening the school during the COVID pandemic, we would appreciate it if parents could ensure that, where possible, only one adult drops off and collects their child(ren) before and after school. Thank you.

Contacting the school to report a positive case of COVID over half term and weekends

If a pupil at St Sampson's tests positive for COVID, it is essential that you contact the school as soon as possible. Obviously, this would normally be via the school office.

Over half term, or at the weekend, please contact me directly via email at <u>jbayne@st-sampsons.wilts.sch.uk</u>. (Please do not use this email address for any other correspondence out of school hours).

In the case of a positive test for a family member, please follow instructions on self-isolation but the school does not need to know until the first day of pupil absence from school.

In the case of a positive test for a St Sampson's pupil or staff member, I will contact the Local Authority, the DfE and Public Health England and they will issue instructions about contacting 'close contacts'. In our case, we anticipate that we will be instructed that 'close contacts' will be the class bubble that your child is working in. It is therefore vital that your contact details that we hold on our school systems are up to date, including mobile 'phone numbers. Please note that only you can update your contact details (email and mobile number) on Parentmailpmx.

As well as contacting 'close contacts' to advise self-isolation, please be assured that the rest of the school community would be made aware of a positive case within the school too.
