Scheduled TD Day - 12.2.21 (last day of this term)

This date was set at the beginning of the year as one of our 5 TD days where school is closed to pupils. If it is looking like we will be coming out of full national lockdown at this point, then this TD day will go ahead. We will be able to use it effectively to ensure that our provision in school going forward is complaint with any newly issued guidance and that the curriculum maps are adjusted following lockdown.

If it is looking like a full national lockdown will continue in to Term 4, then this TD day will not go ahead. Children will be expected to be 'in school' remotely on this day (unless they are registered as critical workers or vulnerable and would normally be in site). Our thinking is that this day can used more productively by staff at the point that we come out of lockdown.
