Welcome back to Term 4! This time next week will be World Book Day and also our last day of remote learning. Friday, 5th March will be a TD day and we are really, really looking forward to welcoming all the children back to school on Monday, 8th March.

Parents' Evenings - Week beginning 22nd & 29th March

Class teachers will be running parents' evenings during the last two weeks of term. These will take place over Zoom as they did before. Teachers and parents will be able to have a real two-way dialogue about the childrens' learning and targets going forward after the period of remote learning.

Please sign up for an appointment time, (with your own pen), on Friday, 5th March, when you bring back your child's books. If you have more than one child, please do not sign up for consecutive appointments as there will be different log ins for each class.

Each appointment will be 5 minutes long. The teachers will make sure that there is a gap between each meeting. You will be sent a Zoom login / dial in for your class. Please join your meeting promptly at your appointment time. The class teacher will then admit you from the 'waiting room'. It is your choice as to whether you wish to use the video feature or not.
