Uniform and Equipment List for September 2021

It is very important that, in order to ensure the best possible start for the new school year, the children come in September with the equipment that they will need.

PLEASE CAN ALL UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT BE NAMED!

<u>Jewellery</u>

No jewellery to be worn at all please, except a watch and simple stud earrings (not hoops). **EARRINGS MUST BE REMOVED FOR PE**. It is helpful either to not wear earrings on PE days, or to provide your child with a container to keep them in so that they are safe. They are the responsibility of your child.

<u>Uniform</u>

All shorts should be grey and the tailored school shorts style, not fashion shorts or football style shorts please. Tights should not be work under shorts.

Nail varnish, sparkly belts and brightly coloured socks are **not** school uniform. Hair accessories shouldn't be too large and must be an appropriate colour.

<u>Hairstyles</u>

Children with long hair (girls and boys) should have it out of their eyes for school work and it must be tied up for PE. It is very helpful if hair is tied up for school anyway as it keeps it out of children's eyes when they are working and can also prevent the spread of headlice. No patterns should be shaved in to short hair. Mohican hair styles are not appropriate for school.

Bags, Lunch Boxes and Water Bottles

CHILDREN IN THE LOWER SCHOOL SHOULD USE A BOOK BAG. CHILDREN IN THE UPPER SCHOOL CAN BRING IN A RUCKSACK WITH THEIR BELONGINGS EACH DAY.

All children should bring a **named** water bottle (water only – not squash) to school. Break time snacks will be provided for children in the lower school. Children in the upper school are welcome to bring a healthy snack for playtime. Neither of these should be kept in their lunch box as the children do not have access to their lunchboxes during the day.

Please can all packed lunches come in a clearly named lunch box and not in a plastic bag.
