
Comic Relief Red Nose Day - Friday, 18th March

School Bus Stop - REMINDER PLEASE


As of this term, the school bus stop is being legally used by a taxi responsible for bringing children to and from our school, as charted by Wiltshire Local Authority.

Parent Interviews - Tuesday, 5th & Wednesday, 6th April

Parents' evening is a really important time for you to meet with your child's class teacher to discuss their progress and learning. Again, following the success of remote appointments last year, which suited some parents well, we are offering a blended approach as we tried to do in October. You can either sign up for an appointment time over Zoom (and a log in will be sent to you), or in person.

In person meetings will take place in the school halls (in the same building as your child's classroom) and there will be opportunity for you to see some of your child's work which will be out in their classroom.

Parent meetings will be no longer than 9 minutes, with each appointment 10 minutes apart and we will have to keep to time due to the blended remote and in person offer. We ask that you support us with this and if you require a longer meeting to make a subsequent appointment.
